Sanctuary Seeks Youth Ages 14-18 for Advisory Council Seats

New Council Seats Created to Foster Youth Participation in Sanctuary Communities

Stellwagen Bank National Marine Sanctuary is seeking to fill a *non-voting youth Primary member seat* and *Alternate member seat* to represent the youth segment of the community on its Sanctuary Advisory Council.

The interest and enthusiasm of youth under the age of 18 is very important to the sanctuary; these students are our future generation of ocean stewards and leaders.

The Sanctuary Advisory Council (SAC) consists of 17 non-governmental members and seven governmental members. This diverse group ensures public participation in sanctuary management and provides advice to the sanctuary superintendent. Since its establishment, the Council has played a vital role in advising sanctuary staff and NOAA on critical issues. The SAC meets three to four times a year.

APPLICANTS must be between the ages of 14-18 and willing to serve a two-year term.
